Don't forget to write your notes on a piece of paper

1. You are visiting Tudor House. It is nearly the end of the day so you are the last person left in the room...

What can you hear?	creak, lonely, excited, intrigued,
How do you feel?	scared

2. Suddenly you hear a noise...

Think About.... What does it sound like? Where is it coming from?

Useful words ...

Crash, rustle, creak, mumble, bang, moan, chuckle

3. You look around and a ghost appears...

Think About.... What do they look like? What are they wearing? How do you react?

Useful words...

Shabby, tattered, smart, old– fashioned, strange, unusual, surprised, scared, intrigued, dazzled, shocked

4. The ghost starts to speak to you...

Think About.... What do they say? What does their voice sound like? What is their name? How long ago did they live in Tudor House?

Useful words ...

loud, quiet, whisper, mumble, croaky, shy, confident, harsh, soft, gentle, kind, angry





5. The ghost asks you to tell them what life is like today...

Think About.... What do you tell them? What is your house like? What do you do during the day? What do you do to have fun?

Useful words...

Modern, house, flat, apartment, brick, carpet, bathroom, bedrooms

6. You ask the ghost more about what life was like for them...

Think About.... What will you ask them? What time period did they live in? What job did they do? What did they do for fun?

Useful words...

Tudor, Stuart, Georgian, Victorian, 20th Century, merchant, painter, shoemaker, servant, book binder, hat maker, museum curator

Want to add more details about your ghost's life to your story? Why not research life in your chosen time period online?

7. You hear an announcement that the house will be closing soon and let the ghost know that you need to leave. Before you go, they give you a present to help you remember them...

Think About.... What did they give you? What does it feel like? How do you react?

Useful words ...

rough, smooth, light, heavy, dusty, unfamiliar, interesting, excited, surprised, honoured, disgusted





8. You decide to give the ghost a present in return...

Think About.... What do you give to them? Why did you choose it? How do they react? How do you feel?

Useful words...

Special, precious, unique, favourite, pleased, happy, unsure, nervous, excited, grateful

9. Now it's time to say goodbye to the ghost...

Think About.... How do you say goodbye? How do you feel? How does the ghost react?

Useful words

Wave, smile, cry, sad, relieved, happy, emotional

10. On your way out you tell the person locking up the house about what just happened...

Think About.... What do you tell them? How do they react? Do they believe you? Do you think you will go back to the house?

Useful words

Shocked, scared, uninterested, excited, intrigued, disbelieving
