English (1 hour)	Watch this video: https://www.literacyshed.com/the-blitz.html You may want to watch this in a dark room, if you can, to help you imagine what it would have been like to be around during The Blitz in World War 2. Write down a range of adjectives, adverbs, figurative language such as similes and metaphors. Use dictionaries, thesauruses and the internet to help you! <i>Think: 5 senses.</i> Challenge: You may want to be creative and make an exciting illustrated word bank.
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be learning how to calculate missing angles around a point. The key is to remember all angles around a point add up to 360°!
