Spelling (30 mins)	You can find all of the resources you need in the day 6 folder on the website.  Today you will be investigating words that end with a double consonant.
Maths (1 hour)	You will continue to learn about unit fractions from last lesson. Complete the tasks in the folder on the website.
English (1 hour)	You will need a pen and paper and the story board, which can be found in the day 6 folder on the website.  You will need to listen to the second part of The Highway Rat (click on the link and watch the video from 3:40 <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bkVoYeCLIXU">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bkVoYeCLIXU</a> ).  Now complete the story board for the second part of the poem. It should follow on from what you did yesterday. However, you will also need to include the sentences which explain the key points.

RE (1 hour)	You will need pen and paper and the worksheet in the day 6 folder to complete your task about sacred places.
