Maths (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to use the X symbol for multiplication sentences.</u></b> We are continuing with our work with multiplication. Please follow the PowerPoint and click on the link to watch the lesson. Pick <b>one task</b> and <b>one challenge</b> to do today. Choose which ones you would like to do: Very Mild, Mild, Spicy and Hot. With Very Mild being less tricky and Spicy being the most challenging.
English (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to find personification in a poem.</u></b> Today we will be continuing our work on personification and look the poem The Sea by James Reeves. For this lesson, you will need paper to draw on, as well as some paper (or the tasks printed), for today's learning. Please click on the speaker symbol in the bottom right hand corner to listen to Mrs Woods explain the learning. You will need to do this on each slide.
Reading (30 mins)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to identify words and phrases that capture the reader's interest.</u></b> <b><u>Text: Mousehole Cat</u></b> In today's lesson we will be looking at particular words and phrases an author uses to capture the reader's interest. Click the microphone on the right hand side to listen to Mrs Woods explain your learning.
Geography (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O: I am learning to locate counties in England.</u></b> We are going to be learning about two different counties in England; Devon and Cornwall. A county is a way of separating parts of England into smaller parts. Look at the post cards and write down one thing you see, one thing you think and one thing you wonder about Devon and Cornwall.
