- 3 Ron needs to share 20 bananas between 5 boxes.



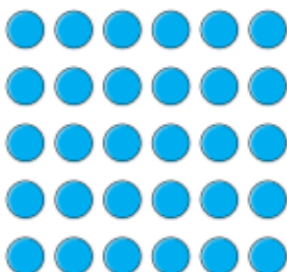
How many bananas will there be in each box?

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How many bananas will there be in each box?

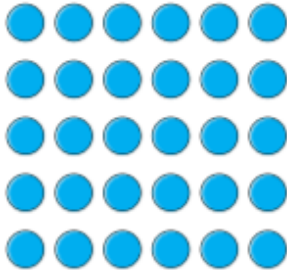
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There will be bananas in each box.
