<b>Thursday 21st January 2021</b>	
PE @ 9:15am (1 hour)	Today you have PE. Please make sure that you are dressed appropriately and that you join in on time. This is a great chance to see all of your friends at school!
Maths (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to multiply by three (3).</u></b> Today you are going to put your times tables knowledge to work. You are going to be answering word problems, showing that you are able to multiply by 3. Open the PowerPoint for Maths and follow the slides. You will also have a video to watch and follow to help you with your learning. Again pick tasks that are best suited to you. If you are finding something too easy or too challenging, change the sheet that you are working on. <b>Remember you do not have to do all of the maths sheets – pick one task and one challenge.</b>
English (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. I am learning to write a poem.</u></b> In English, we are starting to get ready to write our poem. We are going to be drawing pictures to match the storm and we are going to be generating words and phrases to match the images. We will then write descriptive sentences to match our pictures. Remember to click on the speaker on each slide to listen to Mrs Woods explain your learning.
Science (1 hour)	<b><u>L.O. What is it and where does it come from?</u></b> You will need either a cardboard tube, or some paper or card to make a tube with. Your grownup will also need something small and sharp to make a tiny hole for you. Follow the PowerPoint and it will explain your task to you.
