Spelling (30 minutes)	<p><u>LO: I am learning to use a strategy to practise my spellings.</u></p> <p>In today's session, you will be practising the spellings you learned last session using the table as a template.</p> <p>You will attempt to spell the words 4 times without looking. You may want to use 'Say, Look, Cover, Write, Check' if this strategy works for you.</p> <p>The resource can be found in today's folder on the school website.</p>
Maths (1 hour)	<p><u>LO: I am learning to subtract using formal written method.</u></p> <p>In today's session, you will learn to subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number.</p> <p>You can find the worksheet you will need at the end of this lesson in today's folder.</p> <p>You will need to click the link below and then select the 2nd video labelled 'Subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number - no exchange' to start your learning: https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-4/week-6-number-addition-subtraction/</p>
Reading (45 minutes)	<p><u>LO: I am learning to skim and scan a text for information.</u></p> <p>Using the words you found yesterday in the wordsearch, can you find the words in the text and write out the sentences they are in using your best handwriting.</p>
English (1 hour)	<p><u>LO: I am learning to write in the style of Julia Donaldson.</u></p> <p>Today, you will write the next stanza of your animal. Look at the examples as well as my model to have a go. Remember the last words in the second and last line need to rhyme.</p>
Computing (1 hour)	<p><u>LO: I am learning to keep myself and others safe online.</u></p> <p>Today you will be learning to keep yourself and others safe online. You will need to work through the e-safety</p>
