Maths 1 hour	Today you are going to be learning about the inverse operation to multiplication: division! You will be practising your short division skills. Reading 30 mins	Today you will need to read chapter 14 and the start of 15 from Goodnight Mister Tom in preparation for tomorrow's task. Extension: You could make notes about the events in this chapter or the thoughts and feelings of the characters. Tomorrow you will need your story writing skills!
History 45 mins	Today you are going to be learning how daily life would have changed for people during World War II. Open the History Lesson link. Firstly, read the information about our local area in WW2. Then, watch the videos. All the links are on the lesson slides for you. If you want to, you could make some notes on the information that you find out. Finally, using the information you have read today, answer the question on the slides. You only need to write a short paragraph.
RE 45 mins	Focus: Christianity Today's RE lesson follows on from last week with the theme of 'messages'. Last session you needed to think about how messages are part of our everyday life. In this session, you will be thinking about the messages you want the world to know. You will also be beginning to think about how messages are shown in Christian images. Challenge: Do all religions have messages in their artwork? Prove it right or wrong (give examples).
