You, the courageous men, who are so close to us all, have fought hard and we have made much progress in ending the world war. We shall prove ourselves as a great country, a powerful country and a successful country. We will forever be remembered for freeing Europe from the Germans. I have full confidence that the British Empire can defeat Nazi Germany. We must not give up. We must continue to work together and to fight for what is ours and by doing this, I know we will succeed.
