Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. Teacher/Class catch up 9.00 – 9.15	A link will be sent to your school email address for a Zoom meeting with your class teacher. This is an opportunity to discuss your learning for the week and ask any questions that you have about your home learning so far.
French 20 minutes	Today, you are going to continue learning how to describe the features of a face in French. Work through the PowerPoint and use google translate if needed. Then complete the attached worksheet, you can choose which sheet you would like to do.
Maths 1 hour	In today's lesson, you will be learning strategies to be able to efficiently divide by 10. Click on the link to complete the lesson and worksheet. https://vimeo.com/475113712 you can mark your work using the answer sheet. If you have made any errors, can you see where you went wrong and correct your work? <i>Challenge: Try any of the maths challenges set for today if you have completed your work and want to challenge yourself.</i>
Reading 40 minutes	Today, you are going to be continuing practising your inference skills. The focus is going to be on some extracts from our book, <i>Gladiator's Victory – Warrior Heros</i> . Go through the PowerPoint for support and complete the task set.
English 1 hour	For the remainder of the half term you will be revising and revisiting all of the grammar skills that you have learnt in Year 3 and Year 4 so far. Today you will be revising prepositions . Follow the power point by clicking on the play icon and pressing the space bar to work through the steps in the lesson. Remember! These are skills that you have been learning in school. <i>Challenge: Show of the skill in your own super sentences or short paragraph. Underline where you have used prepositions.</i>
History 1 hour	Today you will be learning about Roman Numerals. These are what were used in the Roman number system.
