Reading 30 mins	Using Chapter 15 and the notes you made last lesson, today you will be applying your retrieval skills and justifying your viewpoint by becoming an Agony Aunt and giving advice to William. What do you think he should do? Write a letter giving your advice to William, using evidence from the text to support your advice.
Maths 1 hour	<p>Today you will be learning to convert decimals to fractions. Complete the True or False Starter to see how much you can remember. Watch the video input for the lesson <a href="https://vimeo.com/490693175">https://vimeo.com/490693175</a> and complete the questions on the worksheet plus the calculations worksheet to practise fluency. Complete the second True or False to finish.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Try at least one of the challenge cards.</p> <p><b>Pink Group:</b> Today you will be developing your short division skills and practising the bus stop method further by dividing 4 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers. Don't forget you need to use the bus stop method for short division.</p>
English 1 hour	<p>Today you will be continuing your learning about parenthesis. However, as we are writing an informal letter in role as an evacuee, you will be using dashes and brackets more as they are less formal. Edit the letter so that it contains some examples of parenthesis.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Can you generate some of your own sentences that include brackets or dashes that could be used in your own informal letter?</p> <p><b>Pink group:</b> Please have a go at the main task today, but if you are struggling and would like more practise, look in the pink folder as there is an additional task in there for you.</p>
Computing 1 hour	<p>Today you will be learning about systems. Systems do not necessarily mean a physical computer. Systems can be found in our everyday life and activities. This lesson will show you how.</p> <p>The learning sheets and links you need are all on your activity sheets.</p>
