Name: William (Willie) Beech		Age 8	Origin London
Physical appearance	A slight boy, much younger looking than his eight years, with limp, unkempt blond hair. Grey eyes. Short in stature.		
Health Status	Sickly and pale looking with signs of malnourishment. Some evidence of past injury – multiple bruises and slight contusions sighted. Displays some evidence of low cognitive ability.		
Behaviour	During processing, William has consistently avoided eye contact and has remained largely silent. When he has spoken, he has done so quietly and with poor diction and grammar. When asked to write his name, he was unable to do so, indicating an issue with schooling.		
Other information/causes for concern	Mother is from an extremely pious background and has requested William is lodged close to a church with a suitably religious host. In addition to his poor school attendance, mother has indicated a past history of wicked behaviour and need for strong discipline.		
Placement	Placed temporarily with Thomas Oakley due to proximity to church. To be moved as soon as an alternative is located.
