Zoom Catch up 9:00 – 6ZO 9:30 – 6GS 10:00 – 6MA	Your teacher will zoom with you this morning to explain the week's learning and answer any questions you might have. You will be sent a link to your school email account this morning. Please log into the Zoom promptly.
Times table practice (15 mins)	Log onto TTRS and <b>LET THE BATTLE COMMENCE!</b> For one day only! Get practising and battling. Competition open between 8am and 6pm. Everyone must play for a minimum of 15 minutes as this is your times tables practise. You will be tested again on Thursday so use this time wisely!
Reading (30 mins)	Today you will be using your summarising skills whilst you are reading. We are going to jump ahead a few chapters to the ending, so there is a summary of what you will miss. Then read the extract from Chapter 21. When you have finished, see if you can order the events by putting the correct number in the boxes.  Pink Group: You have got a summary of chapters 18-21 to read. Then see if you can order the events by putting the correct number in the boxes.
Maths (1 hour)	This week we will be recapping fractions, starting with comparing and ordering fractions with the same denominator.  Complete the True or False starter activity and watch <a href="https://vimeo.com/468944608">https://vimeo.com/468944608</a> to help with the work today. Complete the comparing and ordering fractions with the same denominator worksheet. Don't forget to mark your own work too!  Challenge: Compete the comparing and ordering fractions with the same denominator fluency worksheet and use this to write your own set of 5 questions to challenge a friend! Maybe you could have a competition and time yourself or each other completing these via Zoom!  Pink Group: This week you will be learning about fractions. Start by completing the True or False activity – What is a fraction? Next, watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/498327271">https://vimeo.com/498327271</a> to help you understand more about fractions as this will help you with today's work. Complete the 'What is a fraction?' worksheet and don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet!
English (1 hour)	Today you are going to be continuing to develop your character as an evacuee. Refresh your memories of last week's learning. You may want to have your completed evacuee record cards to one side for today's lesson. Watch the videos and then complete an interview in role as an evacuee. When answering the interview questions, think carefully about how your character might answer and why. Challenge: Can you create your own interview questions to answer in role?
Geography (45 mins)	Today you will be continuing to develop your knowledge of the counties in England. Please complete a route map to show the journey would have gone on when he was evacuated. Then answer the questions about this route. Challenge: Can you find an alternative route that Willie could have travelled through?
