Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. Teacher/Class catch up 9.15 – 9.30	A link will be sent to your school email address for a Zoom meeting with your class teacher. This is an opportunity to discuss your learning for the week and ask any questions that you have about your home learning so far.
French 20 minutes	In French today you will revise the names of the parts of the body in French. We challenge you to sing the song without the words! You then need to complete the task, labelling the parts of the body on the worksheet. There is an answer sheet for you to check your work. Take care of your French spellings.
Maths 1 hour	In today's lesson, you will be continuing to learn about equivalent fractions. If you have made any errors, can you see where you went wrong and correct your work? <i>Challenge. Try any of the maths challenges set for today if you have completed your work and want to challenge yourself.</i>
Reading 40 minutes	Today, I would like you to write a book review on 'Warrior Heroes. The Gladiator's Victory'. Please finish the book first, if you have not done so already. There is a template that you could use for your book review, or you can create your own layout. Please send these through to your teacher as they would love to see them.
English 1 hour	For the remainder of the half term you will be revising and revisiting all of the grammar skills that you have learnt in Year 3 and Year 4 so far. Today you will be revising using the apostrophe to show possession and for contractions . Follow the power point by clicking on the play icon and pressing the space bar to work through the steps in the lesson. Remember! These are skills that you have been learning in school. <i>Challenge: Show of the skill in your own super sentences or short paragraph. Share these with your teacher – you could use Google Docs to do this. Underline where you have used the apostrophe correctly. How will you remember not to use the apostrophe for plurals with no possession?</i>
History 1 hour	To conclude your learning about the Romans, today you will learn about the things that they ate and the foods they brought to Britain. You will use what you learn to create your own Roman menu for a Roman feast! How adventurous will you be?! If you are intrigued by what you have learnt, you can try your own Roman recipe at home.
