Spelling (30 minutes)	<u>LO: I am learning to apply the digraph 'ea'.</u> In today's session, you will begin to learn about the long /e/ sound created by using the 'ea' digraph. Maths (1 hour)	<u>L.O. I am learning to compare and order angles.</u> In today's session, you will be exploring what angles are, comparing different sized angles and then putting sets of angles in order. You will need a piece of paper, a pencil and a ruler for this session. You can also use 2 strips of paper and a split pin but these are optional if you do not have them.
