Music 9:30 – 6ZO 10.15 – 6GS 11.00 – 6MA	You will be sent your link for the music lesson this morning. Make sure you arrive on time and have your microphone muted. Please be prepared to share your answers with the class and be respectful of your classmates.
Reading (30 mins)	Today your lesson is on Google Slides and it will be shared with you via email this morning. Go through the lesson and have your volume up as there are some explanations as you go through the lesson that you will need to listen to. For your task, you will be comparing the similarities and differences between Carrie's evacuation experience and William's experience when he was evacuated in Goodnight Mister Tom using the Venn diagram to help you.
Maths (1 hour)	<p>Today you are going to recap subtracting fractions, focusing again on mixed numbers.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. What can you remember about subtracting fractions? Complete the True or False Warm Up activity to get you started.2. Watch the video https://vimeo.com/471345369 to introduce and help you with your work today.3. Complete the 'Subtract Mixed Numbers' worksheet to show what you know. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too! <p>Challenge: Complete at least two questions from the subtracting fractions challenge sheet. Don't forget to mark your work too! There will be more of these tomorrow!</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you will be comparing and ordering fractions. Watch the introduction video in the Pink Resources part of the remote learning page on the school website to help you with the lesson. Complete pages 1 & 2 of the 'Comparing and Ordering Fractions' worksheet. You will need to draw the circles and bar models yourself if you do not have access to a printer. Don't forget to mark your work using the answers on pages 3 & 4 of the same document.</p>
