French 20 minutes	<u>L.O. I am revising how to say the parts of the body in French.</u> In French this week you will revise what you have learned about the parts of the body. You will then learn the names for different parts of the body in French. Click the 'play' button to hear the pronunciation. Maths 1 hour	<u>L.O. I am learning how to multiply 3 numbers.</u> This week you will be continuing to learn how to multiply and divide using efficient methods. Today you will be learning how to multiply 3 numbers together. Can you see where you went wrong? <i>Challenge: Complete the Maths challenges for today's learning.:</i>
Reading 40 minutes	<u>L.O. I am learning to use my understanding of a text to understand new words.</u> Watch the video lesson and follow the PowerPoint slides to work with me to find the meaning of new words in a text. When you have completed the lesson, answer the questions and mark your work using the answer sheet. <i>Challenge: Create your own language questions and send them to me to answer.</i>
English 1 hour	<u>L.O. I am learning to revise speech punctuation.</u> Today, you will be revising your learning of speech punctuation at the beginning and at the end of a sentence. This will be important when you begin to use quotes into your own newspaper report. Complete the video lesson, taking part in the activities as you go.
History 1 hour	<u>L.O. I am learning about the language of time.</u> Today you will be learning about the language we use to describe when things happen in time. You will also learn when the Ancient Egyptian Civilisation began and watch a video to introduce you to our topic this half term.
