Maths (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to recognise coins and notes.</u></p> <p>Complete the True or False activity and then watch the video below and complete the maths questions. You could use coins at home to help you. There are two tasks – one focusing on coins and the other on notes. If possible, have a go at both. Spelling (30 minutes)	<p>Warm up activity—write your name using rainbow writing (each letter is written in a different colour)</p> <p>Complete the two spelling tasks.</p>
English (45 minutes)	<p><u>L.O. History (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning about the Stone Age to Iron Age period.</u></p> <p>Today, you will be learning about Stone Age Britain. You will discover that the period is so long that it's split into three parts and you'll find out what makes each part different. There is a video lesson to accompany the PDF and you'll be asked to watch some videos to support your learning. At the end, you'll create a mind-map of what you've learnt today.
