I am learning to show my understanding of what I have read.</u> Today you will think a bit more deeply about what you have been reading and use this to answer some questions about the story so far by retrieving information and thinking about the language that is used in the story. English 1 hour	<u>L.O: I am learning to draft a recount</u> In today's lesson video, you will be learning how to structure your recount in chronological order. Watch the video and complete the activities as you go.
History 1 hour	<u>L.O. I am learning to identify primary and secondary sources through enquiry.</u> In today's lesson you will learn more about the Egyptians by exploring a range of sources. You will make predictions about what you think each source is, why it was used and who it was used by.
