Maths (1 hour)	<p>Today you will be dividing fractions by integers again to help with your mathematical fluency! Start by completing the True or False Warm Up activity to see what you can remember from yesterday. Can you explain how you know if it's true or false using a pictorial model? Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/480707655">https://vimeo.com/480707655</a> to introduce and help with your work today. Complete the 'Divide fractions by Integers (2)' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too!</p> <p>Challenge: Complete the challenge worksheet of questions to help with your mathematical fluency. Why not challenge yourself further by writing your own set of questions too – these could be arithmetic questions or worded problems.</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you will be subtracting parts of a whole by learning who to subtract fractions from whole amounts. Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/508878193">https://vimeo.com/508878193</a> to help you with today's work. Complete questions 1 – 4. Don't forget to draw bar models to help you answer the questions. Mark your work using the answer sheet. Complete question 5 if you feel really confident and would like an extra challenge!</p>
English (1 hour)	<p>In today's lesson, you will plan your narrative using an S plan. There is an example and some ideas to help you on the slides. Remember, Captain Sir Tom Moore is your main character and try to include as much detail from your research last week as possible, but your story doesn't need to be completely true to his life. You will need a piece of A4 paper for this lesson.</p> <p>Pink Group: Today you will use your picture plan to write the main part of your story. Think about what you decided would happen to Captain Sir Tom.</p>
RE (45 mins)	In RE today, we are going to be continuing to learn about Christianity and the resurrection of Jesus Christ in the Easter story. You will continue to think carefully about the significance of the story to Christians. Your Lesson and Task sheets are on the website.
