World Book Day 10:30-11:00	Watch the World Book Day live event 'Books and the Real World'. Go to the World Book Day website, where you will be able to access the live event at 10:30 this morning. https://www.worldbookday.com/events/
Reading (30 mins)	Today you will be listening to the next part of story today. https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1--ks2-episode5-carries-war/z4q2rj6 Today you are going to be summarising the key events in this chapter by taking photographs of yourself making freeze frames. See the lesson on the website for more detail!
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will continue with learning about fractions of an amount. Start by completing the True or False Warm Up activity to get you started. Can you show your workings using a bar model? This may help you to work it out! Watch the video https://vimeo.com/480708847 to introduce and help with your work today. Complete the 'Fraction of an amount – find the whole' worksheet. Don't forget to mark your work using the answer sheet too! Challenge: If you felt successful with your work today and fancy a challenge, try the multi-step worded problem challenge sheet for more! Pink Group: Today you will be finding fractions of a quantity. Watch the 'Fractions of a quantity' video which will be shared with you via Google Drives. This short explanation video should help you to complete your work today. Complete questions 1 – 4 and question 5 if you are feeling really confident and are up for a challenge!
English (1 hour)	Today, you will write your narrative using the plan you created last lesson. It is up to you whether you draft onto paper or directly onto a Google Doc. Challenge: If you have finished writing your narrative and you have used the checklist to proof-read your work, you could publish your story. There is publishing paper on the website, or you could create a Google Doc to share with your teacher. Pink Group: In today's lesson, you will write the ending to your story about Captain Sir Tom Moore. Then, use the word bank to check the spellings in your work and correct any mistakes you have made.
History (1 hour)	Today you are going to be learning about the British intercepting the German's secret messages during D-Day. The lesson will be shared with you in the morning. Go through the Google Slides and watch the video. You are going to be codebreakers by decoding actual German messages that were intercepted and also making your own secret messages. Challenge? Write your own secret messages using a key you have created. Then give them to someone else to decode.

French (30 mins)	Today you will be continuing to learn some new French vocabulary by continuing to work on the French poem called <i>Dans Paris</i> . Follow the link sent to the Google Slides presentation on the Google Drive and complete the activities. Challenge: How might you practise the vocabulary you're less confident with? Could you apply your English spelling strategies to this at all?
