Maths (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to give change.</u></p> <p>Watch the video on the link below before you complete the main task. If you are finding this tricky, there is a very mild task. Reading (30 minutes)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to understand what I am reading.</u></p> <p>Read through the information on fossils. Then, answer the comprehension questions carefully. Remember to check for the answers in the text. Mark your answers using the answer sheet when you are finished.</p>
English (45 minutes)	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to write the opening of a story.</u></p> <p>In this lesson, we will practise extending sentences using joining words. Following shared writing, we will carry on writing the first part of the opening. For this lesson, you will need an exercise book or paper and a pencil. History (1 hour)	<p><u>L.O. I can describe how sources reveal important information about the past.</u></p> <p>In today's lesson you will be investigating what pictures can tell us about the Stone Age. You will be using your history skills to question sources using what you <i>see, think and wonder</i> to help explain how Stone Age people lived. You will need to become an archaeologist to uncover the 'full picture' and explain what Stone Age life was like. There is a supporting video explaining what you need to do but you will need to use the supporting document to access the videos to find out more.</p>
