

The rules...

Children are put into groups (table). There are given a subject, in this case it is WORDS THAT RELATE TO THE STONE AGE.

Children can challenge any words, but the teacher has the final say!

Round I: Children are given 5 minutes to come up with as many words for each letter they are given. The more words, the more points!

The teams must work quietly to make sure other teams do not hear their words!

When the 5 minutes is over, ask one member in each group to count up how many words they have.

Teacher to note these down.

Round 2: Children must not add any additional words to their lists!

Children are to underline the words that they put down that they think no other teams would have put down too!

Teams can underline as many or as few words as they want.

If not one else has the word that has been underlined, the team will get a bonus point. If other teams DO have the word then the team that underlined it LOSE a point!

Go round the different teams and call out all their underlined words.

Round 3:

The teacher can give out any bonus points for words that they think the teams should have on their lists.

Whoever has the most points at the end wins!

Bonus words

- C camp, caveman, cave
- S spear, spearhead, skins, stones
- T tools, tent, teeth
- F Fossils, flint, fire
