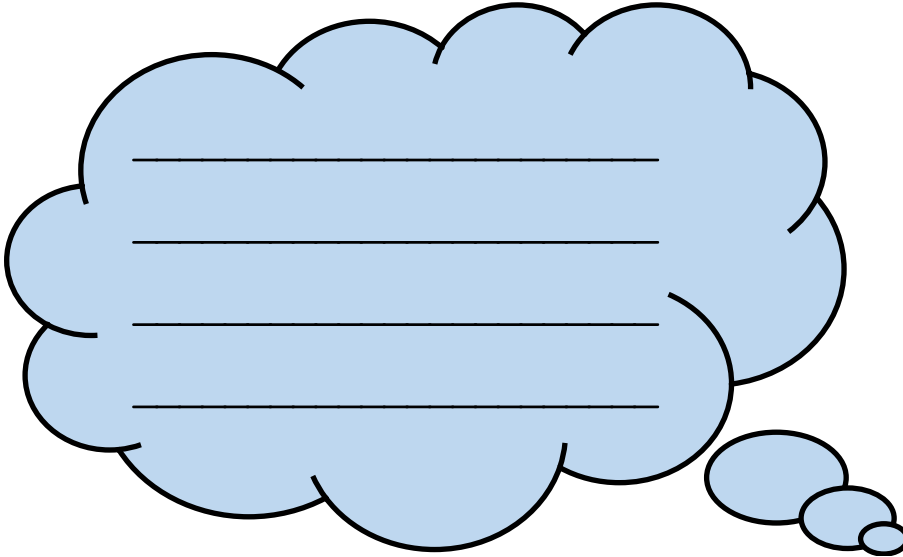

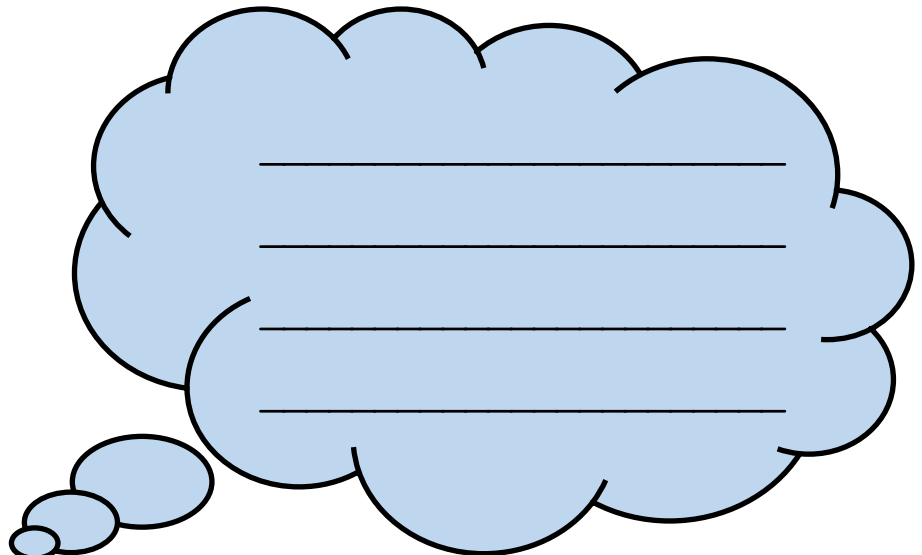
Use the thought bubble to make an inference about how Arthur is feeling at this point in the chapter.
