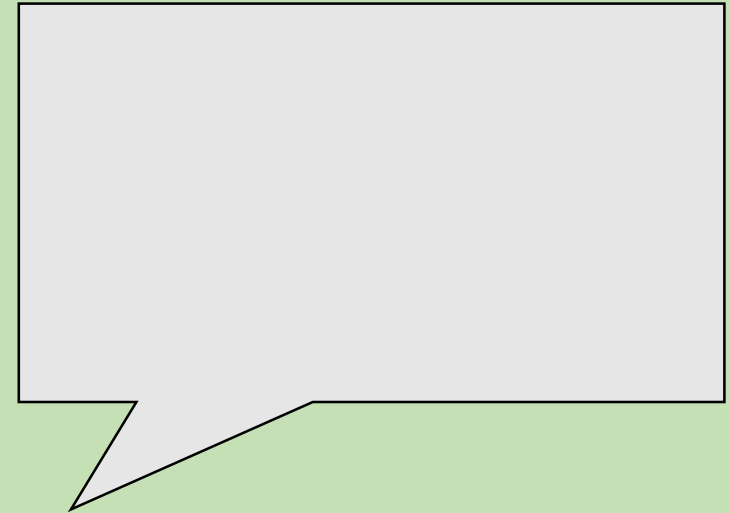

What are the key components of speech first?

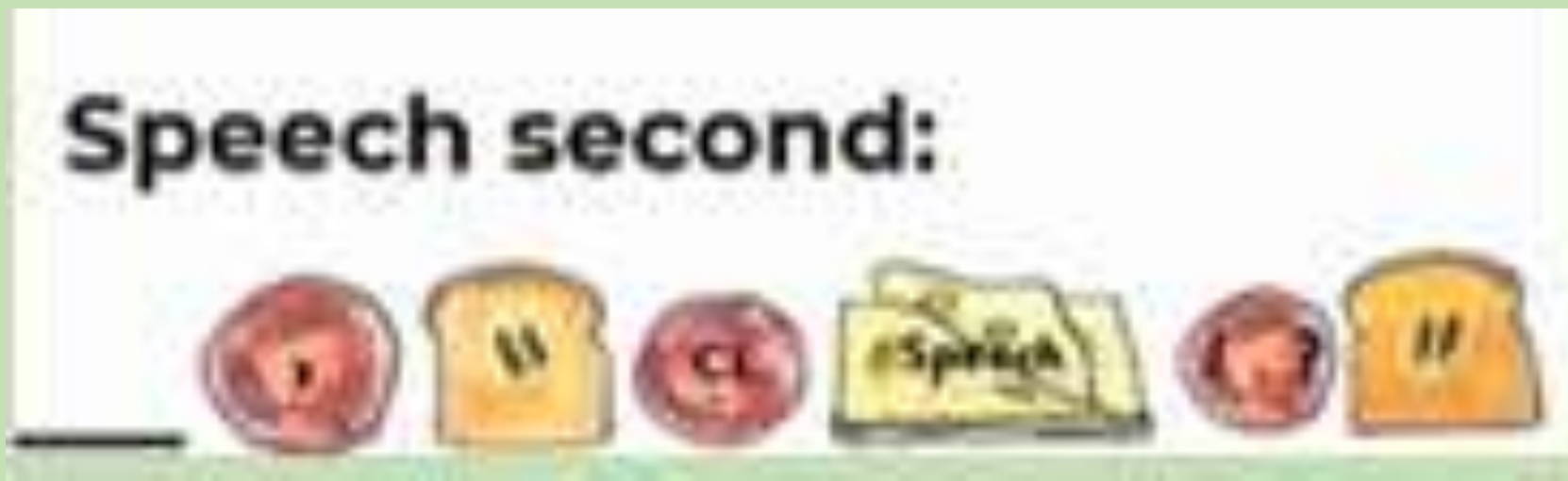
“The first doorway was filled with rubble and broken pieces of jars and pots,” explained the water-boy.



Speech Second

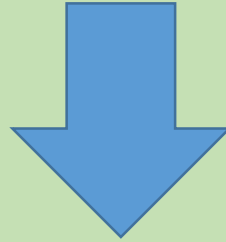
What are the key components of speech second?
