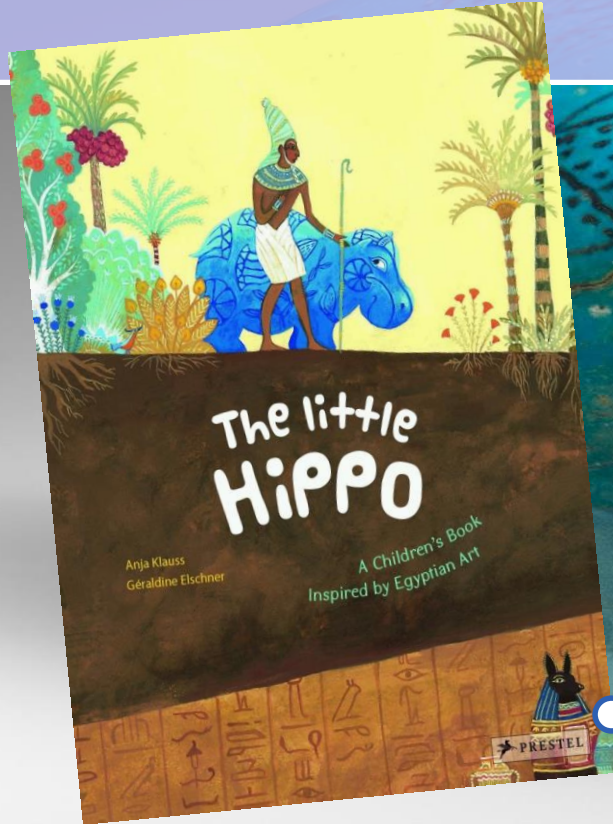

# Hints and Tips

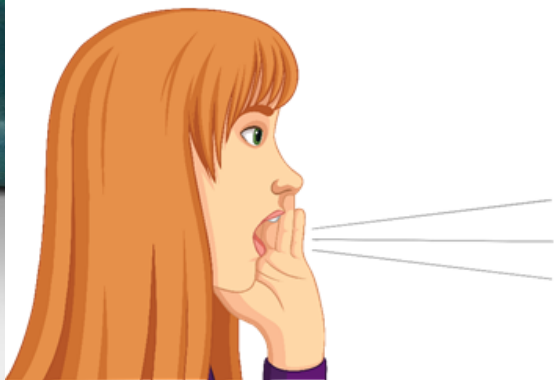
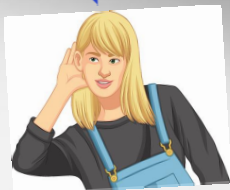
**Read with confidence** and if you don't feel confident, pretend!
