Spelling 30 minutes	<p><b><u>L.O. I am learning to spell words from the Year 3 word list.</u></b></p> <p>Today we are looking at the word guide. What makes this word difficult to remember? How can you remember this tricky word? What will help you? Get someone at home to read the sentence on the last slide to see if you can spell it correctly. Remember to use your neatest handwriting.</p>
English 1hr	<p><b><u>L.O. I am learning to use the features of a diary in a Stone Age recount.</u></b></p> <p>Today, we are going to be recapping the features of a diary. We are going to be reading the text 'Stone Age boy' and generating ideas for our own diary entries.</p>
History 1hour 15minutes	<p><b><u>LO: I am learning to use time lines to describe events that happened in the past.</u></b></p> <p>In today's lesson you will be making a timeline to show the significant changes that occurred during the Stone Age. You will begin to understand how long the Stone Age lasted for and when the events occurred. Please read the PowerPoint information and create your own timeline using the resources. There is an extra challenge of 'walking back' to the start of the Stone Age to see how long ago it was!</p>
