Maths 1hr	<p><u>LO: To find double and half of an amount</u></p> <p>In this lesson you will be exploring the relationship between doubles and halves using amounts. Spelling 30 minutes	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to use the 'r' sound for words with /wr/.</u></p> <p>Work through the presentation to understand the learning today. You will also have some words that you will need to practice this week. Can you think of any other words that use the 'r' sound for /wr/? When you have finished, you could practice your words and handwriting on the handwriting sheet.</p>
English 1hr	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to use the features of a diary in a Stone Age recount.</u></p> <p>Today, we are going to be recapping the features of a diary. We are going to be reading the text 'Stone Age boy' and generating ideas for our own diary entries.</p>
History 1hour 15minutes	<p><u>LO: I am learning to use time lines to describe events that happened in the past.</u></p> <p>In today's lesson you will be making a timeline to show the significant changes that occurred during the Stone Age. You will begin to understand how long the Stone Age lasted for and when the events occurred. Please read the PowerPoint information and create your own timeline using the resources. There is an extra challenge of 'walking back' to the start of the Stone Age to see how long ago it was!</p>
