


Remote Learning Timetable

Maths 1hr	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to recognise and add equal groups</u></p> <p>In today's lesson you will be recognising groups that are equal and adding these groups together. Spelling 30 minutes	<p><u>L.O. I am learning to use the 'r' sound for words with /wr/.</u></p> <p>If you need to, look back at the lesson from yesterday to remind yourself of what you are learning.
