Spelling (1 hour)	<p>Today you will be continuing to practise the letter strings -ough, -ear, -ou, -au and -ice. You will need a pen, colouring pencils and some paper. Take some time to revise the 10 spelling words set in the previous lesson. As well as using a variety of spelling strategies, write a sentence for each spelling. If you are unsure what the word means, use a dictionary or look online for the meaning of the word. Open the link and watch the video from 15.50 to take part in the spelling test. Once you have been tested, check your words and mark them. Maths (1 hour)	<p>In this lesson, you will be applying your knowledge of ratio to solve problems. Start by completing the quiz to recap your learning from last lesson and then watch the video and complete the activities on the worksheet.
