

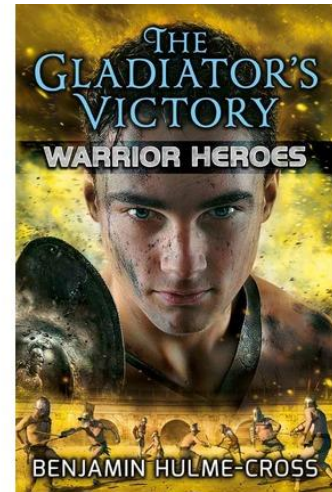
## Gladiator's Victory

Think:

What has happened in the chapter?



- Arthur is called to spar with Ajax, who is a secutor (a stronger, more experienced fighter)
- Arthur is nervous about sparring with Ajax because of his reputation and his intimidating appearance
- Lucius is confident that Ajax is in top condition and that Arthur might come to significant harm - he doesn't care

- As a consequence, Ajax will not be able to fight for Lucius
- In anger, Lucius demands that Arthur take Ajax's place in the arena the next day despite not being ready to fight
- Marcus, the warrior Finn and Arthur are in Rome to save, steers Arthur away and comforts him telling him that he is a 'smart fighter'
- Seeing Marcus, Arthur takes his opportunity to plant the seed about 'fighting for freedom'.
