Dear Parents and Carers,

This term the children have an exciting trip to Butser Farm to look forward to.

Butser Farm – Tuesday 31st March 2020

Next half term, the children will be learning all about the Stone Age era and to support the children's learning we will be taking the children to Butser Farm, near Petersfield. Butser Ancient Farm is a unique experimental archaeology site nestled into the rolling countryside of the South Downs National Park. The farm features archaeological reconstructions of ancient buildings from the Stone Age.

We have been advised by the centre that the children should **NOT** wear school uniform for this trip. This is because many of the activities involve a certain amount of mess and dirt, so children should wear old clothes that you do not mind getting muddy. Please make sure they wear school shoes or sturdy trainers. If it is raining, they can wear wellies. Due to the location of the farm and the time of year, it can be quite cold and very windy. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof jacket, irrespective of the weather conditions in the morning.

Your child will also need a packed lunch in a clearly named plastic bag, not a lunch box, so that the bag can be thrown away. If your child receives a free school meal, we will provide this. The children need to arrive at school at the normal time. The coach will leave at approximately 9.15am and we will arrive back at school by 3.00pm.

The cost of the trip including entrance fees and travel comes to £16.00 per child. However, the school has kindly subsidised £5.00 for each child and so we are asking parents to **contribute only £11**, which is fantastic value for two great learning experiences. Please put your child's name and class on any envelope handed in at the office. You can, of course, pay online at www.fjlive.net.

If there are any changes to your child's medical conditions, please complete and hand in a new medical form before both trips. Medical forms can be found in the school office or on our website.
