Spelling 20 minutes	This week in spelling you are revisiting our phase 3 sounds. You have a sound mat and some activities to complete throughout the week. Can you use the sounds to correctly spell the words relating to the images? Make sure to use the correct sounds and to sound out the words before writing. <i>Challenge: Are there any words you find tricky? Use one of our spelling strategies to practice these.</i>
