Music (40 mins) 3WW 9:30am 3PW 10:15am 3SH 11:00am 3LV 11:45am	You will receive a link your music lesson in the morning. The lesson will be led by the Music Teachers that come into school.

Maths (1 hour)	You will be continuing your learning on length this week. Today we would like you to compare different lengths. There are some ordering questions and some greater than, less than or equal to questions. Be careful, some questions where you will need to convert between different units of measure so make sure you check. Remember 1m = 100cm and 1cm = 10mm. <i>When you have completed this, if you like, there is a challenge for you to have a go at!</i> <i>EXTRA CHALLENGE – Can you and someone at home each make a paper aeroplane and have a completion. Who’s landed the furthest? Using a tape measure, can you measure the distance of when they landed?</i>
