Please see below your lessons for today. Below is a suggested order, however, it is up to you which order you do your lessons. Class Teacher Catch Up 9:15am	This is an opportunity to check in with your class teacher. Lessons for today will be explained and it will also be the opportunity to ask any questions about your learning. If you do not attend the catch up, your class teacher will call home.
Times tables (30 mins)	We have popped some fun activities for you to do to practice your times tables. If you are not confident with your 2,5 and 10 times tables, please practice these. If you are confident with these, work on your 3,4 and 8 times tables. Also, use some of this time to have a go at the challenge set by Mr Viney on TTRS!
Maths (1 hour)	Today you will be adding lengths. Use what you have learned in school about addition and place value to help with this. When you are adding measurements, it's important that all the lengths are using the same unit of measure and not a mixture. Therefore, remember to convert measurements when you need to. <i>When you have completed this, if you like, there is a challenge for you to have a go at!</i>
Reading (1 hour)	In Reading you are going to practice your dictionary skills. Although a dictionary book is ideal, if you have not got a one at home, you can use google to help you. During this lesson you are going to do a lot of predicting what words mean. Think about where you may have seen or heard these words and this will help you! There are two levels of sheets – if you are struggling have a go at the task named supported.
English (1 hour)	<i><u>To generate vocabulary to use in our instructions</u></i> In this lesson, we will recap imperative verbs and sequencing words. We will also investigate using adverbs in instructions and write some sentences using sequencing words, verbs and adverbs.
