Maths (1 hour)	<p>Your job today is to subtract lengths. There are some questions asking you to work out the difference between two lengths; you can do this by subtracting too. As with addition, when you are subtracting it is important that all your values are in the same unit of measure so remember to convert when you need to.</p> <p><i>When you have completed this, if you like, there is a challenge for you to have a go at!</i></p>
Spelling (30 mins)	<p><u>To practise and apply knowledge of suffixes: -er and -est suffixes</u></p> <p>In this lesson, we will practise the rules associated with adding the suffixes -er and -est. English (1 hour)	<p><u>To orally rehearse our instructions</u></p> <p>In this lesson, we will use adjectives to describe our ingredients. French (30 mins)	<p>Today you will be re-capping the numbers in French up to 10 and learning the names of pets and how to say what pets you have.</p>

Reading (1 hour)	<p>In Reading, read up to page 9 again and you are going to think about why an author has used particular words and phrases. Remember, authors (including yourself), make choices on the words and phrases that they use. They want the reader to feel a certain way. Particular words and phrases help the reader understand what is going on. Look at the PowerPoint and have a go at the task.</p> <p><i>Challenge – If you want a more challenging task, skip to the Reading Challenge Sheet after you have worked through the PowerPoint.</i></p>
