PE 9.15-10.15	A link to the PE lesson will be sent to you in the morning, so please check your emails. Remember to wear appropriate clothing, clear a space so that you can move around easily and have a drink of water with you.

You will begin with a short spelling test and a recap on clauses and phrases.
Maths 1 hour	Today you are going to be continuing your learning on 3 decimal places. Everyone is going to have a go at the same tasks today. Remember to email your teacher for some help if you are struggling. Art 1 hour	Focus: World War 2 Soldier Art The soldiers that fought in WW2 are the reason we get to do the things we do today. Study the images of the male and female soldier and create a sketch with shading of one of them. Other option (printer needed): Half and half image – Complete the other half of the image with sketching and shading skills. Tips on how to shade: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-DDTrpJ4PXg Challenge: Why do you think it is important for people to understand and picture what WW2 was like? How do you think art could help/not help this?
RE 45 mins	Focus: Christianity In RE this half term we are learning about how 'messages' are present in the stories in the Bible. This is your first lesson on Jesus' messages. For this session, work through the tasks on the sheet about 'messages' in our everyday lives. Challenge: How are messages being perceived in the media during this pandemic? Are all messages, positive messages? Explain your thoughts with examples.
Spelling and Handwriting 30 mins	Today, we will continue to look at words that use the suffixes –er and –est and you will be tested on the spelling words you were given last lesson.
