	Challenge: Can you write a diary entry as if you are William at the end of that day?
Maths 1 hour	Today you are going to be revising how to divide by 10, 100 and 1000. This is a really important skill to learn that you can apply to lots of different areas of maths.

	detail. Pink group: Read Winston Churchill's speeches and magpie any words or
	phrases you think are effective. Add them to your word bank from last lesson.
