Maths (1 hour)	<p>This week you will continue your learning about fractions. Today, you will learn to compare and order fractions with the same denominator. English (1 hour)	<p>Today you will need to edit your opening and respond to marking.</p> <p>You will need to check for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Capital letters for proper nouns such as Bess.</li> <li>- You have used adverbial clauses</li> <li>- Spellings of any homophones or where you have used the suffix '-ed' (remember those rules). For example, cried.</li> <li>- A range of sentence types that are correctly punctuated.</li> </ul>
