Maths (1 hour)	<u>L.O. I am learning to use equal groups to multiply and divide.</u> Today we are starting our learning on multiplication and division. Open the PowerPoint for the lesson and complete the task. There is a video link for you to click on and this will take you to your lesson. There is a task for you to complete and there are some challenges if you want to have a go at these. You only need to do one task and one challenge. We have labelled the tasks Mild, Spicy and Hot. Choose a task that you feel confident with. Mild being slightly easier and Hot being the most challenging.
Spelling (30 minutes)	<u>L.O. To investigate suffixes: Past and present tense</u> During this lesson you will be investigating the rules that need to be applied when adding the -ed suffix to a verb to change the tense. English (1 hour)	<u>L.O. I am learning to understand what I have read.</u> Today we will be starting our learning on poetry. We will be looking at the poem The Sea by James Reeves.
