French <b>20 minutes</b>	Go through the PowerPoint, clicking the play button to hear the pronunciation and repeat back. You may want to recap your learning of colours from earlier in the week first. Today you will learn the names of some shapes in French and then you are going to say what colour each shape is in French.
Maths <b>1 hour</b>	Today, you are going to be learning about angles and how to identify them. English <b>1 hour</b>	Today you will be revising and exploring simple and compound sentences. You will need to use a range of different sentence structures in your non-chronological report to add detail and improve the way it flows.
