Please see below your lessons for today. It is up to you which order you do your lessons, however, there will be times where we will be meeting online, using Zoom. It is important that you check your emails for any zoom links. If you are struggling, please do not worry, you will have the chance to chat with your class teacher at the catch up sessions. Move onto something else and you will always be able to go back to it.

Teacher/Class catch up 9.15	A link will be sent to your school email address for a Zoom meeting with your class teacher. This is an opportunity to discuss your learning for the week and ask any questions that you have about your home learning so far.
Spelling 20 minutes	Today you will use the look, cover, check, correct strategy to spell words with the long vowel sound, 'igh', correctly. <i>Challenge: Put some of these spellings into your own super sentences</i>
French 20 minutes	Go through the PowerPoint, clicking the play button to hear the pronunciation and repeat back. You may want to recap your learning of colours from earlier in the week first. Today you will learn the names of some shapes in French and then you are going to say what colour each shape is in French.
Maths 1 hour	Today, you are going to be learning about right angles. Today's lesson is a little bit more difficult to find so follow the steps below then click on the link and complete the lesson. You should then mark your work. If you have made any errors, can you see where you went wrong and correct your work? <i>Challenge: Why not go on a right-angle hunt around your house. How many items with right-angles can you find?</i>
Reading 40 minutes	With a family member, read the story of Hansel and Gretel . Use your phonics knowledge to sound out and read any unfamiliar words then discuss and answer the questions for today.

History 1 hour	Today you will be learning about sources and how they help us to find out about the past.
