Maths (1 hour)	L.O. I am learning to make equal groups by sharing. Today we are recapping our learning on sharing. This is something that you would have done at the infants. The lessons will become trickier and the learning that you do today will help you with more challenging questions. Follow the PowerPoint and there will also be a video for you to watch. Again, pick one task and one challenge. Remember to choose a level that you feel confident with.
Spelling (30 mins)	L.O. To practice and apply knowledge of suffixes: Past and present Revising the rules from the previous lesson. Reading (30 mins)	L.O. I am learning to answer questions on what I have read. Text: The Mousehole Cat Today we are going to learn different strategies to help us retrieve answers from what we have read. We will be answering questions on what we have read on page 21 from The Mousehole Cat. There are three different level sheets. You do not have to do all three; you only pick the one you feel most confident with. Remember to click the speaker to hear Mrs Woods explaining your learning.
