



*6 footballs should be circled.
The whole is 12. Half of 12 is 6.*

*5 stars should be circled.
The whole is 10. Half of 10 is 5.*

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 2 = 1$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 20 = 10$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 4 = 2$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 40 = 20$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 6 = 3$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 60 = 30$$

Emily started with 18 crayons. Explanations may focus on adding another equal group/doubling the starting number.



Children may choose to represent this as:

$$9 + 9 = 18$$

$$2 \times 9 = 18$$

$$18 \div 2 = 9$$

Possible answers are 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36 and 38.
