6 footballs should be circled.
The whole is 12. Half of 12 is 6 .
5 stars should be circled.
The whole is 10 . Half of 10 is 5 .
$\frac{1}{2}$ of $2=1 \quad \frac{1}{2}$ of $20=10$
$\frac{1}{2}$ of $4=2 \quad \frac{1}{2}$ of $40=20$
$\frac{1}{2}$ of $6=3 \quad \frac{1}{2}$ of $60=30$

Emily started with 18 crayons. Explanations may focus on adding another equal group/doubling the starting number.

Children may choose to represent this as:
$9+9=18$
$2 \times 9=18$
$18 \div 2=9$

Possible answers are $26,28,30,32,34,36$ and 38 .
