Reading 30 mins	Today you will need to read chapter 8 of Goodnight Mister Tom in preparation for tomorrow's task. After you have finished or while you are reading, make notes about the key events in this chapter or write down the thoughts and feelings of the characters.
Maths 1 hour	Today you will be revising the long multiplication method. There are two worksheets on the website: 3 digits x 2 digits 4 digits x 2 digits You can do a couple of questions from each worksheet or do both worksheets in full if you like! Don't forget to mark your work! Pink group: You can have a go at today's learning but before you begin, you may want to remind yourself of short multiplication. There is a practise sheet for you to begin with on the website.
English 1 hour	Last week you looked at how political speeches were written and the type of words used to create real impact on the audience. This week, you will become Winston Churchill and you will write your own powerful, persuasive speeches! Read the AFOREST information help sheet and complete the 'Features of Speech Writing' task for today from the website. Challenge: Research other great public speakers such as Martin Luther King (I have a dream!) and Elizabeth 1 (Speech to the troops at Tilbury) to find some great examples you might be able to magpie if you can't find examples in Churchill's speech! Pink group: Complete your 'Finding Features' task from the website. You will need to re-read Winston Churchill's speeches again too.
Geography 1 hour	Today you will be learning about the different countries involved in WW2. Read through the lesson and watch the video. Please locate the countries involved in WW2 on your map. Don't forget to mark your work when you have finished. Challenge: Can you group the countries you have located into Allied Powers and Axis Powers? How would you describe where they are using compass directions?
Spelling and Handwriting (30 mins)	 In today's lesson, you will be revising your learning from the Autumn Term about words ending in `-ible' and `-able'. You will then begin to think about related words ending with `-ibly' and `-ably'. You will need a pen and paper for this lesson. Pink group: You will be revising contractions this week. Please read through the information carefully as these are the rules to follow when using contractions and then have a go at the tasks. You will need a pen and paper.
