

Task board:

1. Lay it out
2. Circle the multiplier in the tens
3. Square the multiplier in the ones
4. Ones \times ones
5. Ones \times tens
6. Ones \times hundreds
7. Place value holder
8. Tens \times ones
9. Tens \times tens
10. Tens \times hundreds
11. Add it up!

The circle looks like a zero. This will remind us to put a **place value holder** in later.

Start with the square—it's like the flying flag that starts the race!
