Maths 1 hour	Today you will be continuing to revise long multiplication. If you would like to re-watch the videos from yesterday, please go back to Monday's timetable and click the links. Top tip: You may want to use counters or scraps of paper with the digits 0-9 written on them. ( <i>Remember consecutive numbers mean numbers that are next to each other e.g. 2,3,4 or 7,8,9.</i> )
English 1 hour	Today you will be planning your own speech. You can use the planning template to help you structure your writing or you could create a mind-map to plan each section. Make sure you include lots of the words you've magpied and some of the key features you have looked at this week. When planning, make bullet point notes – do not write the entire speech! Remember the purpose of your speech is to motivate the troops! <b>Challenge:</b> Think about your word choices carefully. You will speak formally, however, might you need to vary your formality to suit everyone listening? <b>Pink group:</b> Use the writing template on the website as well as your word bank from last week to help you plan your speech.
