Learning to type quickly and accurately is an important skill.

• If you practise typing you will notice that you become a lot quicker.

 Some people can type without even looking at the keyboard, this is called touch typing!

Make sure you:

- Sit comfortably with your back up straight and your feet on the ground!
- Use the correct fingers
- Don't rush!
- Always rest your wrists on the desk.

A Keyboard has rows of keys. Today, we are going to practise typing using the BOTTOM ROW.


