| Reading 30 mins | In session 1 of Reading today, you will be studying the two main characters from Goodnight Mister Tom based on what we know about them so far. Both of these things change for the characters as the story goes on so you could include some notes on that. You will need as much information on here as you can, as it will help you with task 2 later on today. |
| Maths 1 hour | Today you will be learning how to divide decimals by whole numbers. | History 1 hour | Today you are going to be learning about WW2 from historical sources. You will look into the meaning of reliability, bias, significance and interpretation. Then look at the photographs you have been given of Southampton during WW2. Please complete 'see, think, wonder' for these photos and refer to reliability, bias, significance and interpretation, if you can. Remember to annotate everything that you can see in the photo, what you think is happening in the picture using evidence and what do you wonder about it? What questions do you have about this photograph? |
